OUR PROGRAMS



READY SET DANCE is a combo class of JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, SINGING and MUSIC. Designed for both boys and girls, the program focuses on teaching the fundamentals of dance while developing confidence, coordination and creativity in a professional and safe environment.

JAZZ

Develop muscle strength, control and balance and achieve coordination milestones like skipping before going to school.

HIP HOP

Bust out some ice cold moves just like FREEZE to our original hip hop tracks.

MUSIC

Develop the musical ear, dynamics and tempo while having fun with instruments and the parachute.

SINGING

Sing like TWIRL and build confidence singing on the microphone.

TAP

Learn the fundamentals of tap in a playful and creative way splashing in puddles and shuffling like a penguin.



OUR PROGRAMS



READY SET BALLETT is magical ballet experience for 2- 5 year olds where they learn the fundamentals of classical ballet.

MUSIC

Engage in specifically designed music that captures the beauty of classical ballet.

CURRICULUM

Develop coordination, body awareness, strength and flexibility both through visual and auditory instruction.

MIME

Explore creativity and gain confidence by going on a picnic with FREEZE and TWIRL, riding the tutu train to storybook lane and so much more.

THEMED DANCES

Learn the beautifully themed dances that have music prompts to support preschooler's playful participation.

PROPS

Have fun twirling with rainbow ribbons, swaying with feathers and popping bubbles. These resources support tactile awareness and strengthen fine motor coordination and control.



OUR PROGRAMS



READY SET ACRO is a collaborative acrobatic program developed with Industry Leader Acrobatic Arts, specifically designed for preschoolers. It emphasises safe and effective progressions to foster the physical and social skills needed for healthy early childhood development.

The program is developed with original music with lyric cues and focuses on three key components: STRETCH, STRENGTH & SKILLS.

STRETCH:

Enhance flexibility and expand the range of motion in all major muscle groups.

STRENGTH:

Young learners engage in a variety of exercises designed to promote physical strength and control.

SKILLS:

Preschoolers develop social literacy and build confidence while exploring a wide range of AcroDance movements, from basic poses and balances, to more complex hand stands and cartwheels whilst always working at an appropriate level for their skill and experience.

Regular and sustained participation in Ready Set Dance classes helps children to develop their confidence as they try new things, practice and consolidate existing skills and experience success and mastery.



👟 COORDINATION 👟

The carefully sequenced and playful program develops physical coordination, the coordination of the senses, the coordination of the mental processes and language and the coordination of social connections.

Can I watch my child's classes?

In our experience preschoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and other siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As preschoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. Our program allows parents to watch the first class if necessary to help them adjust.

Are your teacher's qualified?

All teachers have their Working with Children Check (or equivalent) and follow the program that is endorsed by early learning experts. Ready Set Dance teachers are required to gain their certification from Ready Set Dance head office before delivering the program.

Do we need to purchase uniform and shoes?

Students must wear the Ready Set Dance uniform. However, we need to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before committing to anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official Ready Set Dance uniform at reception which we are sure you will love.

What is watching day?

Watching day is where parents get to view their child dance as an audience in the classroom. It's a chance for your child to begin their first step to working on their performance skills.

If we miss a class can it be made up on another day of the week?

You may swap days during Terms 1, 2 and 3 if you miss a class (as long as the make up class is not full). In term 4, each class works on a different routine for the end-of-year concert, and it is too confusing for students to be swapping days. We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as preschoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

How can I experience Ready Set Dance at home?

Ready Set Dance airs on Nick Jr and Paramount Plus. You can also catch us on YouTube and the Nick Jr Play App. The Show has been so popular that it is now airing in 120 countries all over the world. Preschoolers love to dance along to their favourite songs from the TV show in their classes every week.

FEE POLICIES & DETAILS

Please read these fee policies & details carefully before using our services.

WE OFFER THE TWO FOLLOWING OPTIONS FOR TERM FEE PAYMENTS AT DD:

OPTION 1 / TERM FEE MADE IN 1 FULL PAYMENT BY WEEK 4 OF EACH TERM -
Parents / caregivers will receive their term invoice prior to the commencement of each term via email & have until the Friday of week 4 each term to pay fees in full. Upfront payment options include cash, card or Internet Bank Transfer.

OPTION 2 / DIRECT DEBIT THROUGH PAYRIX OPTION - Parents / caregivers have the option to ask to be set up for direct debits through payrix. Once account is made by the parents / caregiver from the provided link, Dance Dymension will make fortnightly direct debits from your chosen bank account / credit card on a Monday. Dates will be given out in advanced so all families are aware of payment dates. You must email us and let us know if you would like us to organise this option for you.

Anyone that decides to stop their classes / enrolment at Dance Dymension must send an email to dancedymension@hotmail.com with a minimum of two weeks notice. Payment will be stopped after that notice is made.

If your bank details change you must update your account with us immediately. In the case of spilt family invoices - should one side of the family fail to make the payment it will be the responsibility of the other family to make that payment.

We offer great family discounts: 1st child full price each additional child 10% off!

ALL CLASSES MUST BE PAID FOR EVEN WHEN ABSENT. IF YOUR CHILD DECIDES TO STOP A CLASS A WRITTEN LETTER OR EMAIL MUST BE SENT WITH TWO WEEKS NOTICE AND AN UPDATED INVOICE WILL BE SENT WITH THE LAST CLASS ON INVOICE BEING FROM THE EMAIL / LETTER DATE.

In term 3 a concert permission note will be issued this is an optional event however if you do decide to be a part of this extra costs will occur such as concert fee and costume fee.





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
